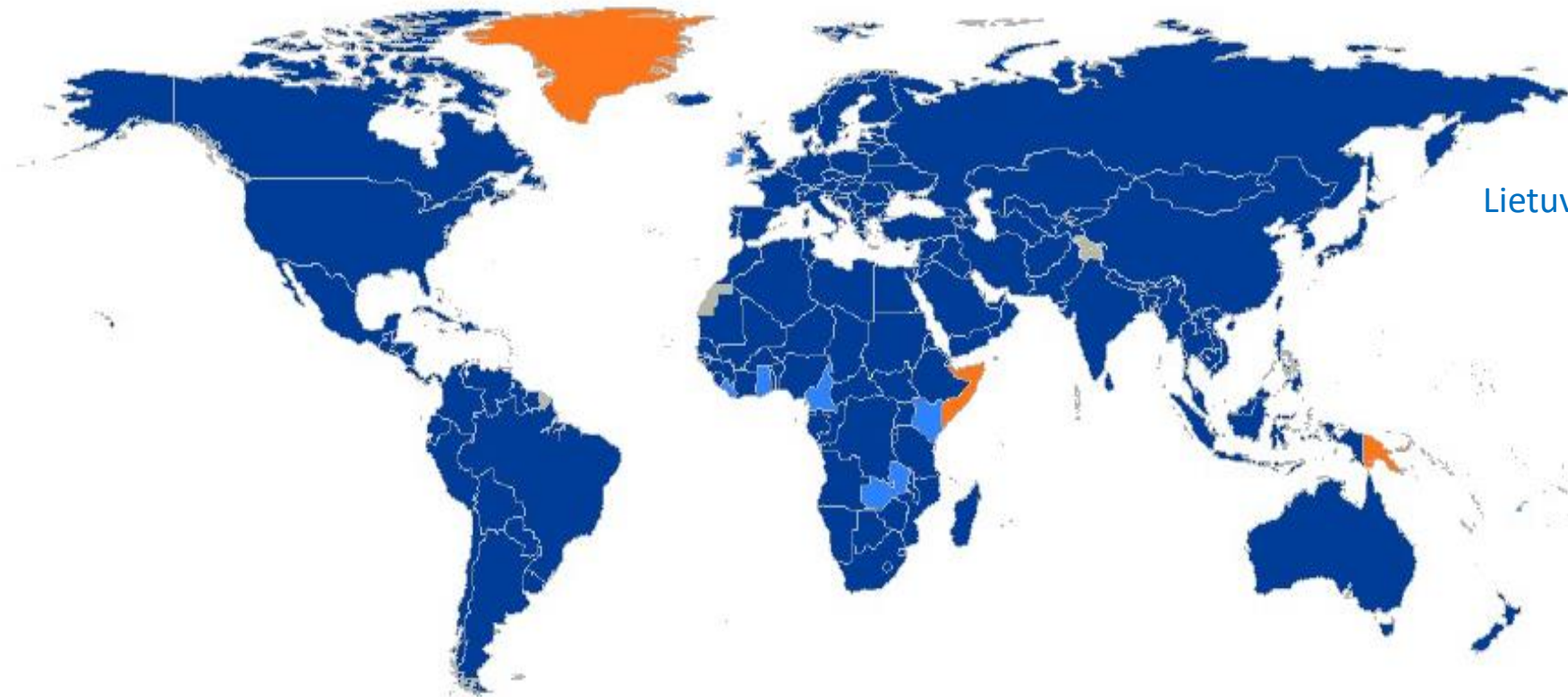

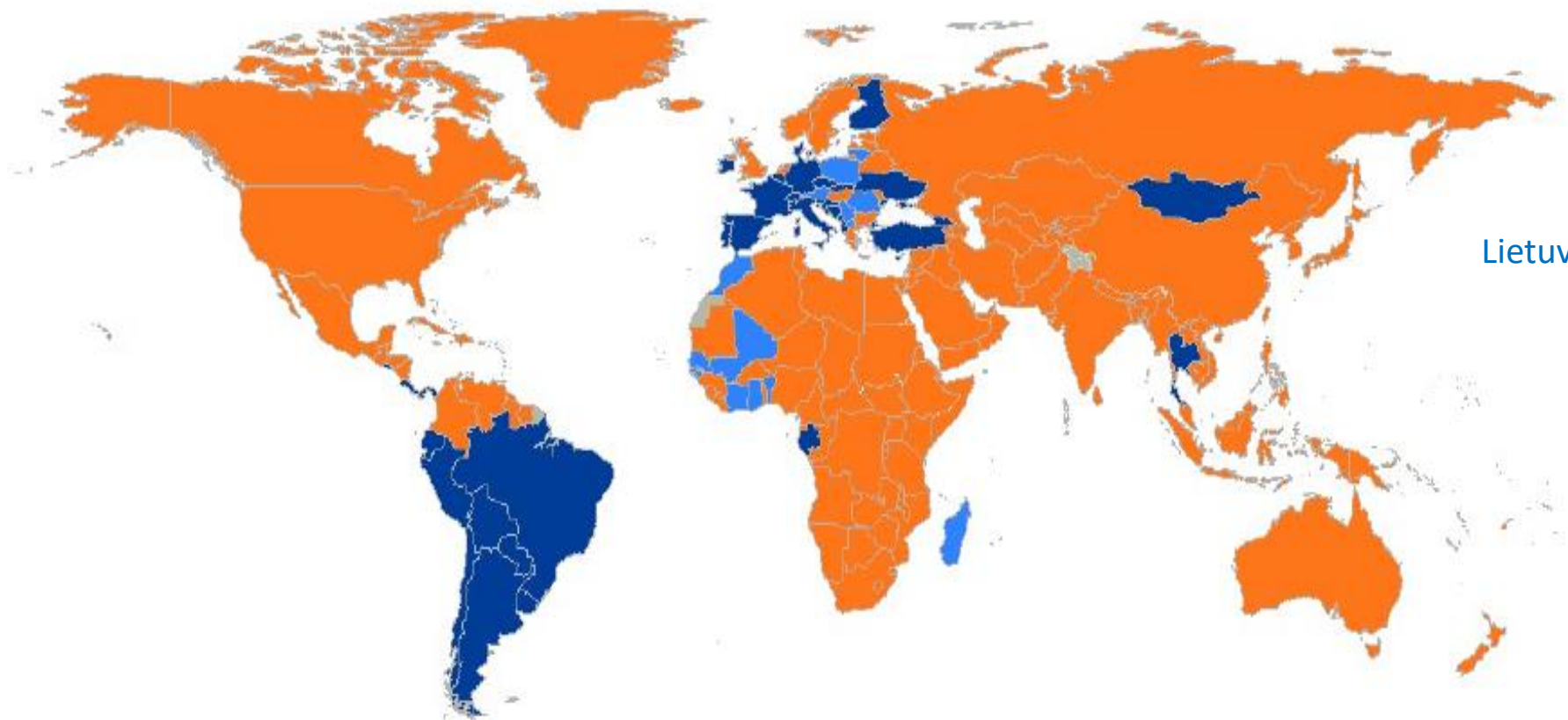

Jungtinių Tautų Vaiko Teisių Konvencija

2 straipsnis

1. Valstybės dalyvės **gerbia ir garantuoja** visas šioje Konvencijoje numatytas teises **kiekvienam vaikui**, priklausančiam jos jurisdikcijai, be jokios diskriminacijos, <...>.
2. Valstybės dalyvės **imasi visų reikiamų priemonių**, kad vaikas būtų apsaugotas nuo bet kokios diskriminacijos ar bausmių dėl vaiko tėvų, teisių globėjų ar kitų šeimos narių statuso, veiklos, pažiūrų ar įsitikinimų.





Jungtinių Tautų Vaiko Teisių Konvencija

4 straipsnis

Valstybės dalyvės **imasi visų reikiamų teisinių, administracinių ir kitų priemonių** šioje Konvencijoje pripažintoms teisėms įgyvendinti. Ekonominėms, socialinėms ir kultūrinėms teisėms įgyvendinti valstybės dalyvės **panaudoja kiek įmanoma daugiau savo turimų išteklių**, o prireikus pasitelkia ir tarptautinį bendradarbiavimą.

Jungtinių Tautų Vaiko Teisių Konvencija


44 straipsnis

1. Valstybės dalyvės įsipareigoja informuoti Komitetą <...> ką nuveikė Konvencijoje pripažintoms teisėms įtvirtinti ir kokią pažangą, įgyvendindamos šias teises, padarė <...>.

2. Informacijoje <...> nurodomi veiksniai ir sunkumai, jeigu tokių yra, trukdantys vykdyti šios Konvencijos įsipareigojimus. Ši informacija turėtų būti tokia, kad Komitetas galėtų gerai įsivaizduoti, kaip ši Konvencija veikia atitinkamoje šalyje.

6. Valstybės dalyvės garantuoja savo ataskaitų viešumą savo šalyse.
