


We operate nationally.

We provide services to early childhood education and care, basic education and additional education.


Approximately 2500 pupils are within the sphere of our services, 13% of whom study at Valteri schools.

Counselling visits and consultation

- Support the learning, school attendance and participation opportunities of a child or young person in their own learning environment
- Meant for children and young people who need support, along with the adults who work with them
- For developing the expertise of the entire working community



Counselling visits and consultation

- Pedagogic and rehabilitative counselling
- Planning of support measures, student placement and further studies
- Support for drawing up pedagogic documents
- Creating a multidisciplinary working community



Support periods

- Support the school attendance and learning of a child or young person in pre-primary, primary and supplementary education and during transition periods.
- The objectives and content of the support period are determined individually together with pupils, their families and local professionals.
- Support periods can be organised either at Valteri Centre schools or at the pupil's own school.



Support periods

- Assessment support period
- A support period focusing on a particular learning area
- Transitional stage support period
- School attendance support period
- Supervised independent living support period



Evaluations and assessments

- for the basis for learning and rehabilitation plans
- to support pedagogical assessment and statements
- focus on the learning and school attendance capabilities
- E.g.
- ➤ communication
- ➤ vision
- > computer usage, and the use of computers as communicational tools
- neuropsychological background behind reading and writing skills, mathematical skills, and learning difficulties.



Rehabilitation

- The aim of rehabilitation that support learning is to promote the student's ability to function and to support her/his learning at various stages of schooling.
- E.g.
- > neuropsychiatric coaching
- ➤ support discussions
- ➤ the regulation of attention
- ➤ language skills
- > interaction and the development of social and emotional skills



Workplace counselling

- Strengthens professional identity and coping at work.
- Focuses on questions concerning work, the working community and one's own work role, as well as specific client and student situations.
- For working communities, employee groups or individual employees.



In-service training

- Teachers in pre-primary and basic education as well as upper secondary education and training, social and health care personnel.
- National, regional, local and school-specific.
- Tailored training packages and training projects.
- Course calendar

VALTERI SCHOOL



Valteri School

- operates in connection with each unit of the Valteri Centre for Learning and Consulting
- is meant for special support students whose school attendance cannot be arranged in the appropriate manner in their home municipalities
- approx. 350 pupils in six units
 - pre-primary and basic education
 - voluntary additional basic education
 - rehabilitation supporting education
- each unit also has housing services for pupils who live long distances from school and for pupils in support periods



A school placement at Valteri School

- a possibility for a family / child
- only for specific reason (main principle: inclusive education)
- becoming a Valteri School student always happens via a support period
 - possible only after an applying process
 - > municipality applies in co-operation with parents
 - > decision according to the child's individual needs
 - > placement not necessarily permanent for whole compulsory education



Valteri School

- a special education school
- Valteri School Curriculum is drawn up on within the framework of the national core curriculum
- each pupil has an IEP
- pupils study
 - according to the "general" curriculum or
 - subjects according to an adjusted (individualized) syllabus or
 - instruction can be provided by activity areas
 - (motor skills, language and communication, social skills, skills in daily functions, cognitive skills)
- teaching is combined with rehabilitation and guidance that support learning
- guiding principle in all school activities is rehabilitative everyday life
